

Make a little sea breeze

Printer-rated matte cardstock. Cut solid outlines; score and fold dashed lines.

Seven sheets / one ten-child celebration

Pages 2–3: 12 tags. Pages 4–5: ten adventure cards.

Pages 6–7: three model boats: two for the table, one spare.

Before you cut

Supply glue, ruler, scissors, hole punch and three paper straws.

Print boats on pale seafoam card; tags and activity cards on cream.

Packing and scale

Tags are 2 × 3 inches; adventure cards are 3.5 × 2 inches.

Label kite handles or storage sleeves after flying, never the flying line.

Seating plan / proposed layout

Five places on each long side, short ends clear: ten total.

Four flower jars and two boats along the center; confirm space on site.

Practice first

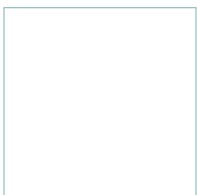
An adult should assemble one boat and one kite before making the whole set.

These paper models are table decorations; they are not water toys.

Host checks

The full design contains venue, supervision, flower and packing instructions.

Keep cardstock scraps and all kite parts together; leave nothing on the beach.

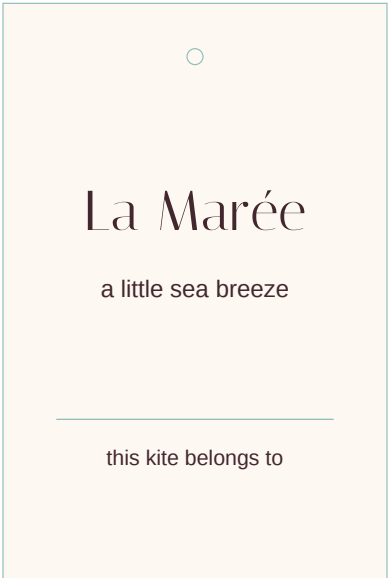
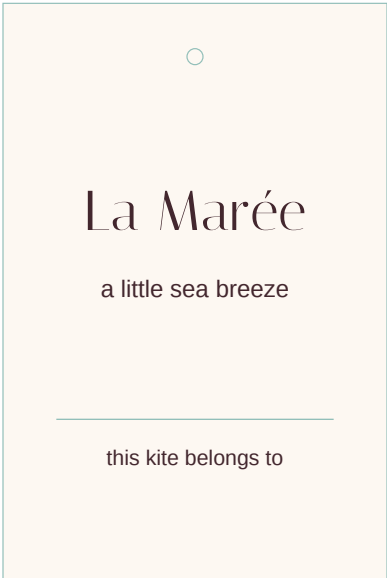
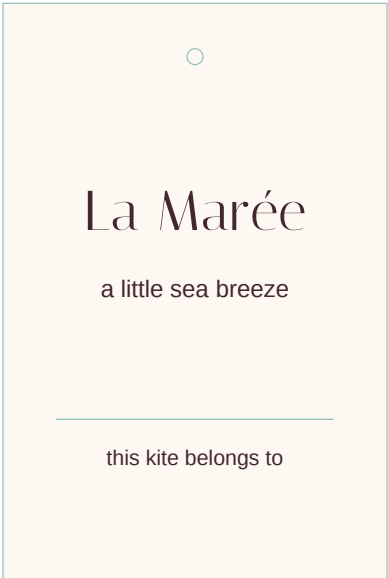
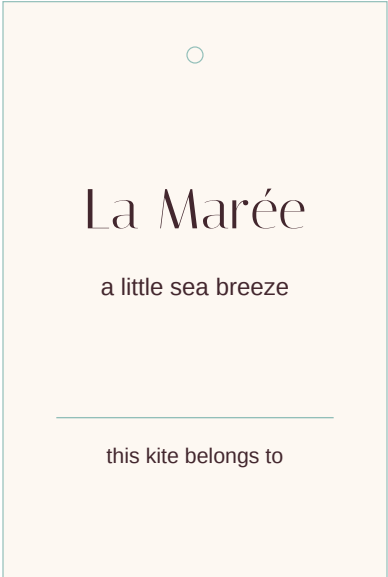
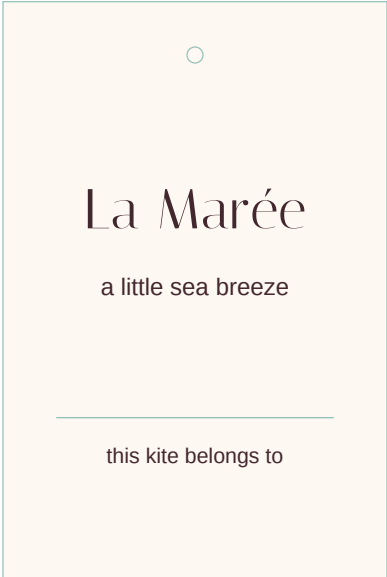
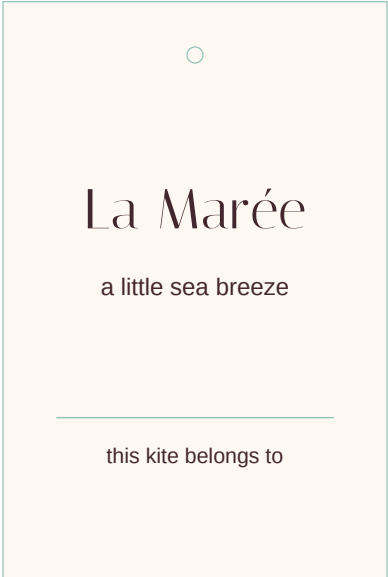


This square must measure exactly 1 × 1 inch.

Disable fit-to-page. Measure before cutting the kit.

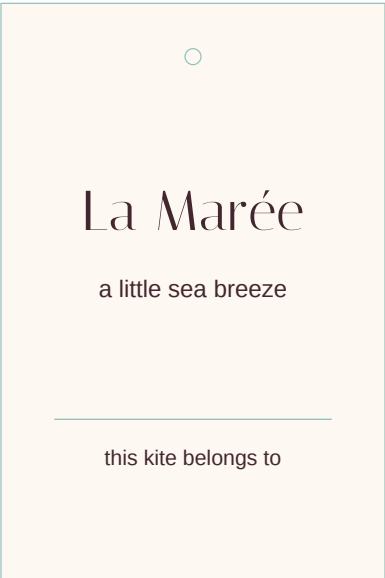
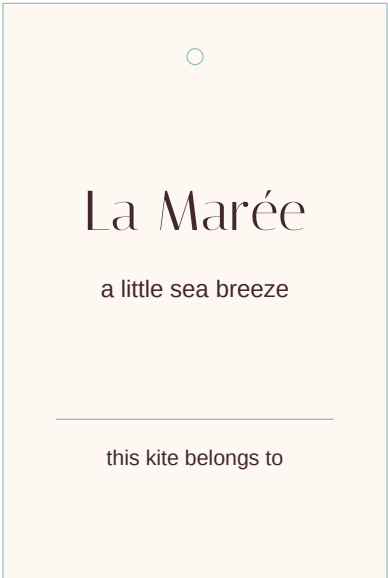
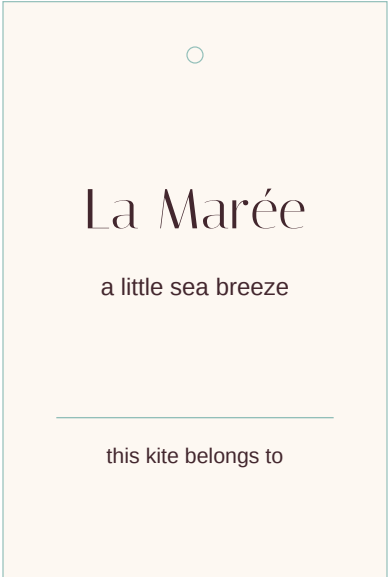

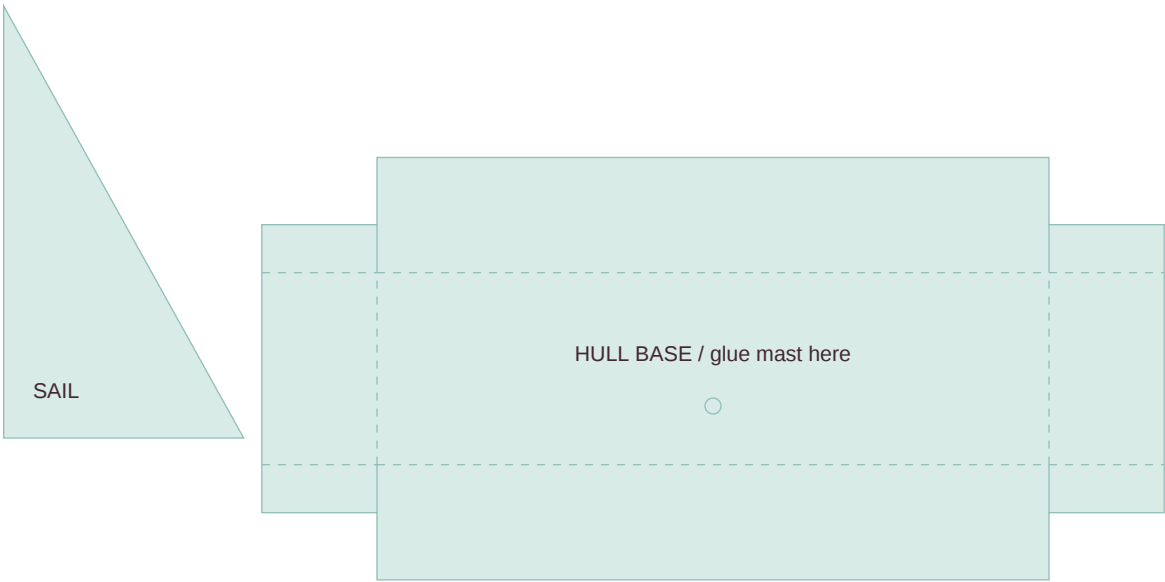

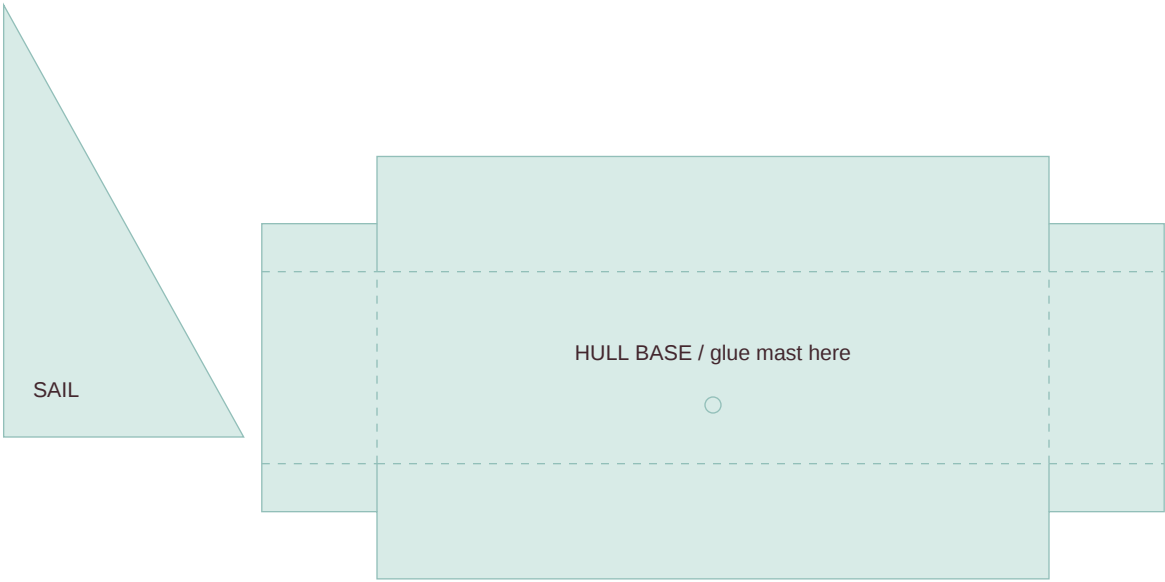

2 template(s) on this sheet / three total / build two, keep one spare



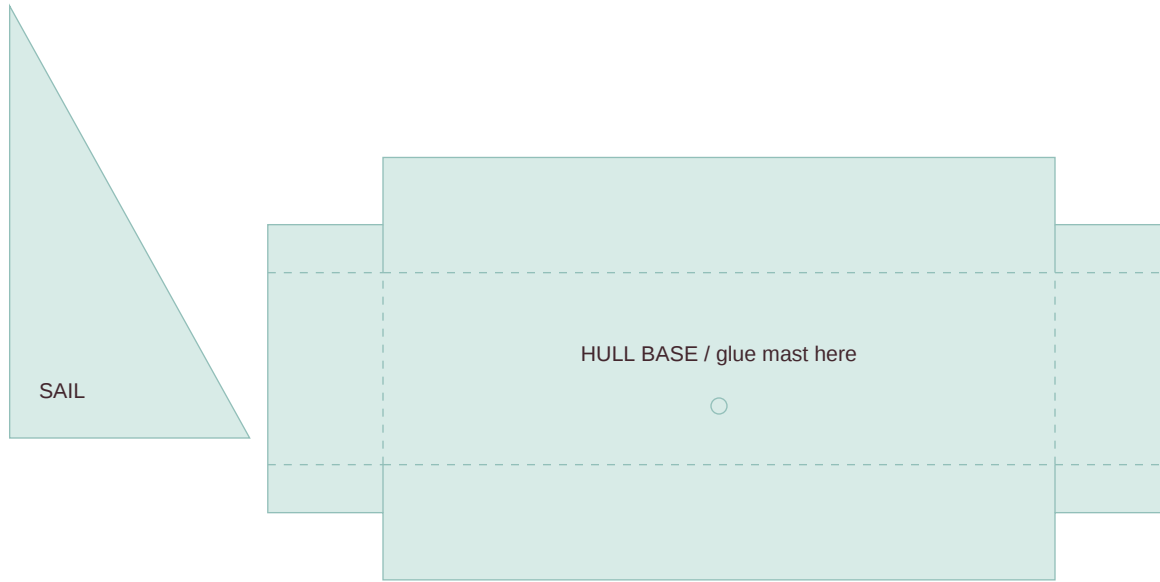
Solid: cut / dashed: fold / small corner tabs: glue inside

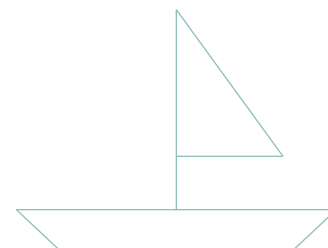


Solid: cut / dashed: fold / small corner tabs: glue inside

How to build each model

1. Cut out the hull net and the triangular sail along the solid outlines.
2. Score the dashed lines. Raise all four sides around the 3.5 × 1-inch base.
3. Fold the four corner tabs inward; glue them inside the adjoining side panels.
4. Cut a paper straw to 3 inches. Flatten its bottom 1/2 inch, fold at a right angle.
5. Glue that foot to the center of the hull base. Hold upright until the glue sets.
6. Glue the sail's straight vertical edge to the straw. Leave the boat to dry.
7. Test the completed model on the table. Keep it away from water and children.

The diagram is a construction guide; handmade folds will vary from the rendering.
