The concept



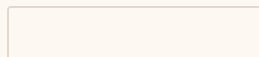
Concept rendering — the design, visualized

Morning light, sage cotton and small white daisies: a first birthday that leaves room for the family. The baby’s familiar high chair stays clear and usable. A small garland and the neutral “1” banner create a separate adult-managed display by the sideboard.

The cake waits on the sideboard with the birthday kit’s pale “One” topper. Take the still-life photograph first, then remove the topper and serve the baby’s portion on a stable child-appropriate surface. The memory is the family together, with time to stop when Nora has had enough.

At home, plan around the baby’s usual routine. Confirm the high chair’s instructions and restraints, keep the photo display out of children’s reach, and choose a separate quiet space for feeding or a nap.

Tablescape & décor plan

A usable high chair

Use the family's own suitable high chair and its restraint system as directed. Leave the tray and chair free of balloons, tassels, flowers and strings. The illustration is a layout concept, not a product recommendation for a high chair.

A separate birthday backdrop

Use about 36 balloons from the sage, sand-white and white kit for one compact garland. Attach it to a suitable adult-installed wall support above the sideboard, separated from the chair and play area. Mount the "1" tassel banner on the sideboard display, never on the baby's tray.

Four jars and one vase

Use twelve mini daisy stems in four small cream ceramic vessels: three per vessel. The remaining six daisy stems go in one taller sideboard vase. Add one of the five included foliage stems to each vessel. The garland has no flowers, so none are missing from the count.

The adult table

Ten ivory dinner plates, sage hemmed cotton napkins, gold plastic utensils and clear cups. Keep spare dessert plates at the cake station. No gauze runner or napkin rings are required in this version.

The Alela Moment — the first taste

One adult handles the cake and removes the topper, one photographs, and a caregiver stays with Nora. Keep the moment brief and follow her cues. Guests write a wish for her next chapter; her parents keep those cards together.

Your shopping list

Reviewed for ten adults, three baby guests and Nora. Cotton sage napkins replace the paper towels shown as fabric; the neutral birthday kit already includes a topper, so the duplicate wooden topper is removed. The subtotal is a shortlist, not a complete under-\$150 party: cups, support supplies, cake, stand and any missing furniture still need costing.

If you prefer real daisies

Replace the entire \$19.99 artificial daisy-and-foliage pack with fresh feverfew. Use three usable stems in each small vessel and six in the tall vase: 18 in total. Their own foliage gives the airy green accent; no artificial greenery remains in this option. This is a more delicate, higher-cost version.

Feverfew Chamomile · six bunches Typically 5–8 stems per bunch, 30–48 before conditioning. Supplier warns of 25–35% loss; count at least 18 usable stems before arranging. Scale the tall vase down if needed; do not promise identical density.	\$150.00	view →

A separate Flower Moxie order. Confirm the event date, delivery ZIP, shipping charge, substitutions and claim deadline before paying.

Linked purchases with fresh table flowers: ~~\$268.34~~, before unpriced essentials, tax and shipping.

Order ahead: allow at least 14 days and confirm the supplier’s current lead time. Schedule arrival about three days before the event. Have clean buckets, flower food and shears ready; unpack, photograph problems immediately, remove submerged foliage, recut and hydrate in a cool room. Keep an artificial backup if delivery or usable yield falls short. Containers must be watertight. Fresh flowers stay away from food and children’s reach.

The keepsake — for the family

This celebration leaves the family a keepsake: ten wishes for Nora's next chapter and a complete set of twelve month cards. A privately shared photograph can become the guests' thank-you.

Paper, ink and a keepsake envelope still need supplying. The napkin and plate in the detail are table styling; they are not take-home gifts. The daisies stay in their arrangements, so no stems or napkins are counted twice.



The honest list — what's not included

These are the remaining supplies and practical checks for this version. They are part of making the party work; they are not included in the Amazon subtotal.

REQUIRED: CONFIRM, BORROW, HIRE OR BUY

Furniture and five vessels	Confirm seating for ten adults, a suitable high chair for Nora and feeding arrangements for the three other babies. Measure table and sideboard before choosing cloths. Borrow four stable cream ceramic vessels about 4–5 inches tall and one taller vase; fit-test the stems and keep everything beyond little hands.
Garland support and tools	Borrow a balloon pump. Add wall-compatible support hardware rated for the complete display, soft ties and scissors. We have not verified your wall or a support product. Follow its load, surface and cure-time instructions; glue dots only join balloons, they do not support the installation.
The cake station	Order a baby-appropriate cake/portion with the family and baker. Borrow a stable white cake stand sized to its board, plus proper knife/server. The pictured stand is an unpriced styling requirement, not a verified listing. Remove decorative topper before the child approaches; confirm a food-safe barrier with the baker if cake-contact suitability is not documented.
Cups and baby service	Provide twelve clear plastic adult cups: ten + two spare; add coffee cups if served. Have four sets of family-approved feeding ware/bibs and spare cloths for the four little guests. The adult plastic plates and utensils are not a baby feeding kit.

Paper, clips and keepsakes	Printable kit: eleven US Letter sheets, comprising instructions, twelve month cards, one sample “Nora is one” sign, and twelve 5 × 3.5-inch memory cards. Supply printer-rated matte cream card, pencils and a keepsake envelope. Month cards need twelve photos and a freestanding adult-only display or secured clips; no cord near the chair or play area.
The welcome and cleanup	Drinking water, food labels and allergy information from the hosts, chilled-food storage, wipes, waste bags and a quiet feeding/changing corner. One adult does a final floor sweep for balloon fragments, clips, stems and packaging before children enter.

Season & comfort

Follow the baby’s day	Keep the party length flexible, the sound gentle and the room comfortable. Leave a quiet feeding/nap room available and identify the caregiver who can step away with Nora.
Keep little hands free	Adults manage the display. Balloons, broken pieces, topper, clips, tassels, wires and artificial flowers stay out of children’s reach. Keep the high chair’s restraints in use according to its instructions.
The keepsake is for the family	No food or loose-piece favor is given to the babies. The milestone display and written wishes stay with the parents; a shared family photograph is optional, not an automatic public post.

Printables

Twelve months	Twelve numbered month cards, with spaces for the family’s own photos. These are the parents’ keepsake; do not distribute the only set as favors.
A gentle welcome	One “Nora is one” sign for this fictional sample celebration. Use on an adult display; the name can be changed in the source generator.
For your next chapter	Twelve cream memory cards: ten adults + two spare. Guests write a wish on the back. The parents keep the originals and may later share a photograph privately.

US Letter · print at 100% / actual size, not fit-to-page. Check the one-inch test square before cutting. Templates are draft artwork for this sample celebration.

Setup guide

Finish noisy inflation and cutting the day before. Allow two adults about 60–90 minutes for display and table setup, with a 20-minute buffer before guests; baby care and cooking need separate time.



The staging — representative pieces grouped for preparation; use the written quantities

Before ordering	Measure the wall, table and cake board. Verify the complete birthday-kit contents so a second topper is not purchased. Test the selected wall support on the actual surface using its instructions.
The day before	Inflate with a pump, sort the kit's three colors, and build a short trial garland. Check every vase and stem for loose parts. Print month cards, welcome sign and memory cards; prepare the photo display away from children.
Build the display	Install the support and small garland above the sideboard. Keep cords and tassels outside the reachable child area. A gentle stability check must pass before the high chair is brought into the scene.
Set the adult table	Linen, ten settings, four low daisy arrangements. Put the taller vase, cake stand and topper at the adult display. Keep the child's tray clear; position the camera so window light falls from the side.
Before the first guest	Check high-chair restraints, clear the floor and close away spare balloons and tools. Set water out, identify the quiet corner and put pencils beside the memory cards.
The first taste and goodbye	Photograph the cake, remove topper and decorations, then let a caregiver offer the prepared portion. Pause when needed. Gather wishes in the parents' envelope; share photos only with the family's permission.

The small garland

Sort before inflating	Planning recipe: 12 sage + 12 sand-white + 12 white balloons, mainly 10/12-inch sizes with a few 5-inch accents. The listing does not state each size/color count: check the delivered mix before committing to this exact recipe. Use the kit's available balance or source a matching top-up and update the illustration.
Build on the strip	Inflate to the maker's guidance, avoiding overinflation. Feed tied necks into the strip, alternating colors and sizes; use glue dots for small accents. Do not glue flowers to balloons or use the high chair as an anchor.

Support, then inspect

Use the verified wall supports and soft ties to carry the strip. No universal anchor count or load is assumed. Keep the whole display outside children's reach, clear of the high chair and exits. If the support cannot be made suitable, leave the garland out and keep the sign as the focal point.

The daisy recipe

Arrange all eighteen stems

Open the three tied daisy bunches. Allocate 3 + 3 + 3 + 3 stems to the small vessels and 6 to the taller vase; use the five foliage stems one per vessel. Bend stems within vases; enclose any cut wire ends.

Keep flowers in the vessels

Do not decorate the cake, high chair or baby's clothing with these stems. The table works with artificial or separately sourced fresh flowers, but use only one complete recipe at a time.

When the glasses rise

One year of firsts — first laugh, first steps, first cake she is about to wear instead of eat. Nora, take your time with the rest of them. And to her parents: may year two be gentle. To Nora!

A starting point, not a script — your revisions can tailor it to your people.
